Minor earthquake hits Kanchanaburi

Kanchanaburi's Sai Yok district was rattled yesterday by a small earthquake but there were no reports of any casualties or damage.

The tremor, which measured 2.3 on the Richter scale, struck at 11.51 am. Its epicentre was near tambon Tha Sao in Sai Yok National Park, about 18km from Sri Nakharin dam.

Boon-in Chuenchaowalit, director of Sri Nakharin dam, said the seismic activity did not cause any damage or affect the dam.

He noted that the earthquake was hardly felt by anyone.
